Similarly, in a non-fictional narrative essay, the same pattern is followed where one is supposed to present a thesis statement at the end of the introductory paragraph. It does not matter whether it is a fictional or non-fictional narrative essay it has to follow the conventional pattern and should be serving a purpose.
