

Formatting Guide for MLA Style – 2021

MLA citation is one of the widely used citation styles across all fields of study. Research papers are formatted mostly using either MLA or APA styles. It is important to know the proper formatting styles. If you have put together a research paper after a painstaking effort and at the end have failed to use proper formatting style then the whole strenuous work would be of no use. So, always follow the step-by-step guidelines while using [write essay for me](#) in order to ensure proper formatting that lends credibility to your research paper.

Here are some of the basic rules to follow:

- Always use 1-inch margins on all the sides
- The first word of a new paragraph should be indented by one half inch
- Always use Times New Roman with 12 font
- The entire paper should be doubled spaced [write essay](#)

The Header

- Begin one inch from the top and left-aligned
- Write your name, the name of your instructor, course number, and the date one below the other doubled spaced
- Write a title that is centered aligned and do not capitalize, bold, or italicize it
- Period should not be placed at the end of any headings
- The first line of the text and the title should be doubled spaced [write an essay for me](#)

Running Header

- It appears on the right corner of the page with last name and page number

Works Cited

- All the sources should be mentioned under the left aligned title of ‘works cited’
- All the sources should be mentioned alphabetically



- There should be double space between them
- It is the last page of the research paper at [writing service](#)

In-text Citation in MLA

Use in-text citation if you use a direct quote, paraphrase or summarize from another source. And also make sure to list the corresponding entry in the reference list. It should contain the last name of the author and the page number i.e. (Smith 102). If there is no page number then ignore

it i.e. (Smith). If there are two authors then separate them by 'and' between them i.e. (Johns and Smith 122) and if there are more than three authors then write et al. with the last name of the first author i.e. (James et al.). In the case of multiple works separate them with the help of semicolons i.e. (John 111; James 222). In case if there are no authors then use the title instead of the name of the author. The in-text citation must lead the reader to the corresponding link in the reference list as you observe in the case of an [skilled writers](#) where one link leads to another in the page.

Citation for Electronic Sources

- Write the author's or editor's name

- The article name should be enclosed by quotation marks
- Title of book, project, or website should be italicized
- The publisher's information should also be mentioned that contains the name of the publisher and publishing date

An Image

- Mention the artist's name along with the date of creation coupled with the name of the institution and city of production. The work of art should be italicized. It has come to our common observation that students often find it difficult and resort to [reliable essay writing service](#) to get their research formatted and it is a bad practice because it does not benefit the student in the long run.

A Tweet

- If the tweet of a person were to be used as a source then the name of the author followed by Twitter username in the bracket. Put a period after the bracket and write the whole tweet inside the quotation marks followed by a period at [CollegeEssay](#). Also, you should include time and date as per the time zone of the reader. The date and time should be separated with a comma ending at a period i.e. Raymond, Tom (tomraymond). "Corona is the biggest threat." 30 Jan 2021, 12: 13 a.m. Tweet.
